RE: Solar Eclipse Permission

As you likely know, there will be a partial solar eclipse viewable in Plainview on Monday, August 21st from about 11:30 AM-2:30 PM. Our teachers are making some plans for our students to experience this spectacle but we are not planning a school-wide viewing event. I expect that most or all of our students will at some point be given the opportunity to go outside and see it.

We will be providing eclipse glasses for our elementary students but we can't guarantee that a student will not look directly at the eclipse without eye protection. Students will be supervised at all times if taken outside to view the eclipse and they will all be told of the safety measures that they need to follow.

We need all students that want to go outside during the eclipse to return this signed letter to their teacher in the elementary or the office in the high school. If we do not have this permission letter, we will not allow your child to go outside to view the eclipse.
