Timing- <u>RICO Timing Systems</u>

· Spreadsheet of all pre-registrants, in the format specified by the Company, seven (7) days prior to the Event.

 $\cdot$  We will then need an updated spreadsheet of all pre-registrants, in the format specified by the Company, no later than 48 hours prior to the Event.

 $\cdot$  Provide an updated spreadsheet with registrants taken within 48 hours of race start no later than 2 hours prior to Event start.

• All coaches representing their schools may drop or change division for his or her cross country runner no later than 30 minutes before the designated start time.

 $\cdot$  Race bibs must be worn on the front and be uncovered when passing the timing points. The timing equipment works on line of sight and any participants who wear bibs incorrectly may not receive a time. It is imperative that the Event communicate this clearly too all participants to ensure quality and accurate results.

• There will be 20 medals for boys and 20 medals for girls in the junior high race.

Schedule of events

High School girls will run at 4:00 p.m. High school boys at 4:45 p.m. Junior High school girls will run at 5:20 p.m. Junior High school boys at 5:40 p.m.

• We will have some Gatorade after the meet for runners.

• If you have 4 or more runners you will receive a team score. Fifth and 6th place runners will act as "pushers" when scoring.

• Junior high will score 3 runners for the team score-no "pushers".

• You may run as many runners as you like. Junior high: only "attached 7th and 8th graders". Sorry no unattached or younger runners.

• Concessions will be available on site
