GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Students must successfully complete the courses required by the board and the Nebraska Department of Education in order to graduate.

It shall be the responsibility of the superintendent to ensure that students complete grades one through twelve and that high school students complete 265 credits prior to graduation.

Credits will be required according to the following:

Areas of Study	Graduation Requirements
English	40 Credits English 9, 10, 11 English Composition/12
Speech	5 Credits
Mathematics	30* Credits Algebra I, II, Geometry
Social Studies/ History	40 Credits Geography, World History, American History, American Government Economics

Science	30* Credits Physical Science, Biology
Health/Physical Education	10 Credits Health and Physical Education
Visual and Performing Arts	10 Credits
Foreign Language	10 Credits
Electives - minimum	80 Credits
Total	265 Credits

*An additional 10 credits must be earned in the areas of math and/or science with the science courses to include chemistry or general science. These additional courses must be approved by the administration prior to the student enrolling in the respective classes. Courses of study will be reviewed by the board annually.
