Plainview Public Schools Board of Education Meeting Monday, January 11, 2021

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Education of District 5 of Plainview, NE, was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mike Sauser, President, on Monday, January 11, 2021. Rasmussen moved, Frahm seconded to declare an open meeting. Upon roll call vote, the ayes were unanimous. Motion carried. The rules for open meetings were posted at the back of the room. Roll call was answered by Sauser, Jim Thor, Tim Rasmussen, Wyatt Frahm, Deb Jensen and Chance Anderson.

OATH OF OFFICE

Superintendent Arlt administered the oath of office to newly elected board members, Deb Jensen and Chance Anderson.

REORGANIZATION OF THE BOARD

Superintendent Arlt took charge of the meeting for the election of board president. Rasmussen nominated Mike Sauser for board president. Anderson nominated Dr. Jim Thor for board president, and then later rescinded his nomination of Dr. Thor. Upon roll call vote, Sauser was elected president.

Chairman Sauser then took charge of the meeting. Dr. Thor nominated Wyatt Frahm for vice president. Upon roll call vote, Frahm was elected vice president.

Frahm nominated Tim Rasmussen for board secretary. There were no other nominations. Upon roll call vote, Rasmussen was elected secretary.

CONSENT ITEMS

Consent items included the minutes of the December 14, 2020 regular meeting, the financial reports, and the January claims. The financial report (with last month's figures in parentheses) showed a balance of \$60,411.80 (\$467,722.56) in the General Fund. CDs total \$1,000,000.00 (1,000,000.00), Special Building Fund \$619,074.44 (\$620,804.81), Petty Cash \$1,169.65 (\$2,456.04), Activity Account \$133,721.84 (\$134,959.27), Lunch Account \$30,999.19 (\$1,621.66), Employee Benefit Fund \$52,215.79 (\$52,206.92), Depreciation Fund \$113,643.50 (\$113,619.38), Payroll Account \$4,473.46 (\$4,201.33), Custodial/Section 125 Account \$15,604.38 (\$15,926.45). Total assets were \$1,950,295.17 compared to \$2,289,178.48 a month ago, and \$2,225,344.94 a year ago. December receipts totaled \$94,327.67. That compares to \$60,698.86 in November. Disbursements totaled \$501,638.43 including \$124,339.94 for claims and \$357,298.48 for payroll, and \$20,000 transfer to Lunch fund. Building Fund receipts totaled \$3,142.13. Building Fund expenditures were \$4,872.50. Claims to the General Fund totaled \$81,018.88. Frahm moved, Rasmussen seconded, to approve the consent items. Upon roll call vote, the ayes were unanimous. Motion carried.

Jensen moved, Frahm seconded to approve revised policy 504.19-Student Fees as read. Upon roll call vote, the ayes were unanimous. Motion carried.
