

## **Plainview Public Schools Board of Education Meetings**

### **Monday, May 11, 2026**

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Education of District 5 of Plainview, NE, was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by Tim Rasmussen, President, on Monday, May 11, 2026. Anderson moved, Justin D. Doerr seconded to declare an open meeting. Upon roll call vote, the ayes were unanimous. Motion carried. The rules for open meetings were posted at the back of the room. Roll call was answered by Rasmussen, Wyatt Frahm, Justin D. Doerr, Melissa Doerr and Chance Anderson. Caden Alexander arrived at 5:42 p.m.

Justin D. Doerr moved, Frahm seconded to approve the agenda. Upon roll call vote, the ayes were unanimous. Motion carried.

### **CONSENT ITEMS**

Consent items included the minutes of April 13, 2026 regular meeting, the financial reports, and the May claims. The financial report (with last month's figures in parentheses) showed a balance of \$1,223,909.20 (\$1,233,526.09) in the General Fund, CDs total \$1,000,000.00 (\$1,000,000.00), Special Building Fund \$103,286.68 (\$86,042.58), Petty Cash \$2,490.34 (\$2,500.72), Activity Account \$48,805.07 (\$23,723.82), Nutrition Account \$25,857.80 (\$15,853.60), Employee Benefit Fund \$55,259.94 (\$55,196.88), Depreciation Fund \$75,512.65 (\$75,426.48), Payroll Account \$96,968.64 (\$96,934.53), Custodial/Section 125 Account \$18,442.17 (\$16,177.57). Total assets were \$2,513,229.01 compared to \$2,542,148.09 a month ago, and \$2,652,916.66 a year ago. April receipts totaled \$545,448.69 compared to \$951,403.51 March. Disbursements totaled \$555,065.58 including \$63,234.18 for claims, \$20,000.00 transfer to the Nutrition Fund, \$50,000.00 transfer to the Activity Fund and \$421,831.40 for payroll. Building Fund receipts totaled \$32,584.33. Building fund expenditures were \$15,340.23. Claims to the General Fund totaled \$137,303.48. Anderson moved, Justin D. Doerr seconded, to approve the consent items. Upon roll call vote, the ayes were unanimous. Motion carried 5-0.

## **ACTION ON SETTING SUBSTITUTE TEACHER SALARY FOR 2026-2027**

Anderson moved, Melissa Doerr seconded to approve a raise of \$5/day for substitute teachers for the 2026-2027 school year to \$145/day and \$190/day for long term subs. Upon roll call vote, the ayes were unanimous. Motion carried 6-0.
