

Plainview Public Schools Board of Education Meetings

Monday, August 10, 2026

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Education of District 5 of Plainview, NE, was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Tim Rasmussen, President, on Monday, August 10, 2026. Anderson moved, Justin D. Doerr seconded to declare an open meeting. Upon roll call vote, the ayes were unanimous. Motion carried. The rules for open meetings were posted at the back of the room. Roll call was answered by Rasmussen, Wyatt Frahm, Justin D. Doerr, Melissa Doerr, Caden Alexander and Chance Anderson.

Frahm moved, Anderson seconded to approve the agenda. Upon roll call vote, the ayes were unanimous. Motion carried.

CONSENT ITEMS

Consent items included the minutes of July 13, 2026 regular meeting, the August 5, 2026 special meeting, the financial reports, and the August claims. The financial report (with last month's figures in parentheses) showed a balance of \$2,290,312.12 (\$2,707,387.89) in the General Fund, CDs total \$1,000,000.00 (\$1,000,000.00), Special Building Fund \$52,513.90 (\$248,433.40), Petty Cash \$2,486.41 (\$1,801.22), Activity Account \$29,059.26 (\$40,735.54), Nutrition Account \$9,625.58 (\$15,295.67), Employee Benefit Fund \$55,453.78 (\$55,388.39), Depreciation Fund \$225,937.19 (\$75,688.16), Payroll Account \$96,186.99 (\$96,273.58), Custodial/Section 125 Account \$17,032.51 (\$15,490.76). Total assets were \$3,647,481.35 compared to \$4,187,863.39 a month ago, and \$3,664,177.49 a year ago. July receipts totaled \$201,303.35 compared to \$423,439.81 June. Disbursements totaled \$618,379.12 including \$72,529.22 for claims \$395,849.90 for payroll and \$150,000.00 transfer to Depreciation Fund. Building Fund receipts totaled \$2,380.50. Building fund expenditures were \$198,300.00. Claims to the General Fund totaled \$131,126.39. Anderson moved, Alexander seconded, to approve the consent items. Upon roll call vote, the ayes were unanimous. Motion carried 6-0.

Upon roll call vote, the ayes were unanimous. Motion carried 6-0.

Justin D. Doerr moved, Melissa Doerr seconded to budget \$3,000.00 to support Plainview Public Schools TeamMates Mentoring Program. Upon roll call vote, the ayes were unanimous. Motion carried 6-0.
